We are above national in all areas but we are particularly proud of our 100% at standard in Year 6 writing! The children have made excpetional progress since their end of Year 2 testing which means that our school will be ranked as being very high performing. We have had to send a number or papers back (Year 6 papers) for remarking so I will report on final results once they return!

Sincere thanks go to Mrs Tassell and Miss Haley who have worked through their planning time, and worked long days all through the weeks to ensure all children reached their potential. The books demonstrate the high standards that the children have achieved all year round and we know they are well prepared for the higher expectations of KS3 (Secondary School). The children have been taught outstanding lessons all year and they have made great progress. We know the children are moving onto Secondary School prepared - well done to you all! Thank you to all Our Lady's teachers who work so hard to ensure the children fulfil their potential.

We are also 10% above national for our end of reception GLD data and we achieved 100% passrate in our Year 1 phonics! Such a sucessful year! Thank you to Miss Youds and the Year 1 team for their hard work and dedication.
