We will receive the SATs results at the beginning of July and we will let Year 6 know the outcomes when we know.



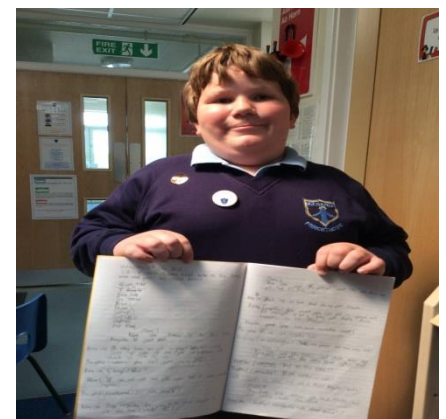
