Looking at Learning


Thank you for all the support that you showed during our looking at learning this week. It was great to see so many of you and delightful to see the children looking so proud of their achievements.



Infection Control & Medication

Please can we remind all parents that no medication should be sent into school directly with your child without completing a medicine form and handing it into the office with the medication. Also at this time of year when there are all sorts of bugs, germs and viruses around, in order to minimise the spreading of illnesses we ask parents to consider whether your child is well enough to attend school. Reminder - if a child has had sickness or diarrhoea they must not attend school for at least 48 hours since the last occurrence. Currently whilst we have so many cases, if your child is infected with Ringworm they must stay at home for the first 3 days of treatment following a visit to their GP. Thank you for your support in minimising infections for other pupils and staff.


A letter detailing dates will be coming home with the children. Please note the final date as the children taking part must be available for the final race.


