Time Tables – how many do YOU know?

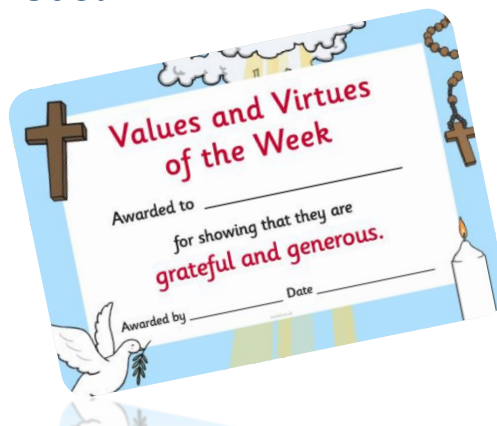

Reminder – if a child has had sickness or diarrhoea they must not attend school for at least 48 hours since the last occurrence. Currently whilst we have so many cases, if your child is infected with Ringworm they must stay at home for the first 3 days of treatment following a visit to their GP. Thank you for your support in minimising infections for other pupils and staff.
