## Snapchat

It has been brought to our attention that some children in our school are using the App 'Snapchat'. Content shared and discussed on this App is causing social problems in school. We would like to remind parents that the legal age for using this App is 13.

Children downloading Snapchat may be redirected to a kids version of the App 'Snapkidz' SnapKidz users can't

add friends or share anything, and the app doesn't send any information to the company. Instead, photos and videos are saved just to their devices' "camera roll." This means you can only play with the photos, etc. in SnapKidz on your own device—not share them.

However, children may look for other ways in which to share the images or content, such as Facebook, texting or email. They may also be tempted to simply enter a fictitious birth date in order to access Snapchat. We will be undertaking some sessions with certain year groups in school to support safe internet use. However, we would ask for your co-operation and support as parents in this matter. Thank you.
