
School Meals



Parents are not permitted to park in the carpark unless there has been prior permission from me. <u>This includes after school hours when you are collecting from care club.</u>


There are still a few parents who are doing this. Car registration numbers will be put into the next newsletter if this persists, which I would rather not have to do.


