Considerate Parking

As a school we do understand that there is very little available parking around our school site particularly as vans are blocking the road at the moment, however this is the situation that we have to deal with. Unfortunately local residents from the cottages at the end of the road have complained that on a number of occasions parents use their driveways to park on. On several occasions they have been blocked in for a period of time and on a recent occasion one resident was blocked in meaning that they missed a doctor's appointment and also received a rude reply when asked to move their car. This is unacceptable and does not keep with the ethos of our school. Thank you for your support in this matter.

<u>Gate</u>

This week the gate has been opened at 8.45am a change to before. This is due to the Before School club now accessing through the main entrance. Children are not to be left unattended before this time. From 8.45am a member of staff is then present on the playground to supervise the children ready for school to start at 8.55am. Children can attend Before School club if they are needing to be dropped off earlier than 8.45am. Next week we are having an intercom system installed at the main reception so parents will not have to phone when they are waiting to drop off or collect children from Before or After School Club. We apologise that it has not gone to plan straight away this week in that respect. Having the gates locked before and after school is a safeguarding measure to keep the site and therefore the children and staff safe. There will always be a member of staff with the children in the classroom/outside when a pupil is being collected or brought back to the office and our ratio meets the legal requirements for this. We thank you for your patience in getting used to the new system.
