Warwickshire Road Safety Club

Warwickshire Road Safety Club visited pupils at school yesterday to deliver interactive and engaging road safety education workshops. The workshops reminded all pupils of the Warwickshire Road Safety Code:

THINK about roads STOP and WAIT before the kerb LOOK and LISTEN carefully for traffic THINK about what to do CROSS safely, looking and listening



Workshops reinforced safe behaviours and the importance of making safe choices. For KS1 pupils this included holding hands with a trusted adult, staying away from the kerb and always looking for a safe place to cross with an adult. For KS2 pupils, key messages included identifying hazards, limiting distractions and taking responsibility for making sensible and safe choices.
