Dear parents, pupils, governors, staff and parishioners,

The month of October is a traditional time to pray The Rosary: a set of prayers to God, our Lady and the Holy Spirit. In Monday's Mission Assembly children will be learning that, after reflecting on a passage of scripture (called a 'mystery'), we say a set of prayers (called a 'decade') including the Our Father, ten Hail Marys and a Glory Be. We use the beads of the rosary to help us keep count, but fingers can work too! You might like to pray the rosary with your child this October:

#### Harvest Appeal — supporting Rugby Foodbank

## COVID quidance

If a child or adult in school displays any of the three main COVID symptoms whilst in school (continuous cough, high temperature/fever, loss or change in sense of smell or taste) they will be supervised in isolation until arrangements can be made for the individual to leave the school site. 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It is advised that a test is arranged for the symptomatic child /adult. This should be available by appointment at a testing site or by post. If a test isn't taken, the individual and their household is expected to remain at home for 14 days.

Any individual who tests positive will need to isolate for 10 days until well and fever free for 48 hours. Other household members will need to isolate for 14 days. A negative test result will bring an end to any isolation period as long as the individual has been without a fever for 48 hours.
