Work books not set by school

We are aware that some families are using workbooks that have been purchased and not recommended by school e.g. Maths CPG. Can we offer a word of caution with doing this please. It is really important that you aim to complete the work that has been set by your child's teacher as they are setting work that links to the curriculum your child would have been following in class. Workbooks are great as an extra but are not helpful every day replacing the tailored lessons and work teachers are setting as your child is missing out on key learning for their age. This means they will have potentially missed new learning.

Message for our Key Worker families where children are in school

Following on from the message in the newsletter last week please contact us if your child/ren are able to reduce their hours in any way for the following week.

Can we please reiterate that if there is a parent working from home or at home as their job is not currently able to operate then that child or children <u>should not</u> be coming into school as Key Worker children under the updated guidance. If there are days that children could be at home some days of the week e.g. due to shift patterns we are more than happy to accommodate that and not have the children in full time - a change to our original information. We would just ask that you inform us by Friday lunchtime what your requirements are for the following week. Next week in some cases, we may need to ask for evidence from employers to ascertain evidence of Critical Worker status.
