Catch Up

This term we have continued our catch up strategy (this can be viewed on our website). Teachers are working incredibly hard with children to plug gaps due to missed time in school. To give an example of this Maths is being adapted to look at what has been missed and needs to take place so that children will be ready for entering their next year group. Additionally, in each class there are a range of interventions taking place, tutoring in Y3,4 and 5 for selected children to boost confidence and skills and a continued focus on basic skills in English or Maths. We are planning that teachers will be able to have a face to face meeting with all parents before the summer holidays so they can give a really accurate update of how hard your children are working and where they are in their learning. More information will be given about this very soon as it is restrictions dependant to the format.


<u>Homework</u>

Here at Our Lady's there has been a lot of debate over the year about using books such as CGP for homework. Currently we are not looking at using these books.
