New playground!

I am delighted to tell you that we are having our playground resurfaced during the summer holidays. We have managed to secure funding from the Diocese to resurface the playground - as it is in a terrible state and also to replace the perimeter fencing and make that more secure. The work is very costly due to the nature of it so we are delighted to have secured 90% of considerable funds to make this happen. The school will have to contribute 10% towards it which comes out of our building fund. The demands on our budget are such that we asking parents for a small annual voluntary contribution of a suggested amount of £30 per family to contribute towards the 10% cost. Parents can now make donations online via ParentPay. Thank you to all our parents who continue to support our school by making regular contributions to our Building Fund.

The work on the fencing is due to start before the holidays and all work will be completed before the children return in September.

School Uniform

We are in the process of changing who our uniform supplier is. For next year you will be able to source all uniform items from Andy Blair's shop which is based on Moseley Avenue in Coventry. This will give families the opportunity to either order online or be able to book an appointment and go into the shop to try on items before buying. Our school will be live on their website from the last week of term and information will be given beforehand of how to order etc. We were delighted with the quality of the hoodies which we source from here so know that our new uniform will be of a good quality as well as them being able to offer a personalised service.
