The consultations will take place in the hall so that they can be social distanced. We ask that you do not arrive more than 5 minutes before your appointment time. Appointments will be no more than 10 minutes long. You will be asked to give details for track and trace and also wear a face covering whilst inside the building.

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
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Mass with Father Teddy
