


Chair – Kirsty Maclean

2020/2021 School Year in Review

The last school year saw us all have to endure a second lock down with many restrictions impacting our ability to support the full range of activities we normally would. We had no fete's, fayres, discos and bonnet parades which was heart breaking as we know how much the children and their families enjoy these events.

Covid, combined with funding cuts meant that our wonderful school faced some incredibly difficult challenges and we were determined to help weather the storm, and we will continue to do so.

EDUCATIONAL ENRICHMENT





Lockdown demonstrated the reliance we all have on technology and exposed a shortfall in the school's provision. To help, we purchased 15 new iPads with tech support to enhance learning across all areas of the curriculum. It's not just about tech! With the school's focus on reading, we funded a library subscription providing children in KS1 &2 with access to a full and rich selection of books all year.

GRANT APPLICATIONS AND DONATIONS


