For the last week of term children are welcome to wear their Christmas Jumpers on Wednesday when they have their Christmas dinner and then again on Friday for the last day.

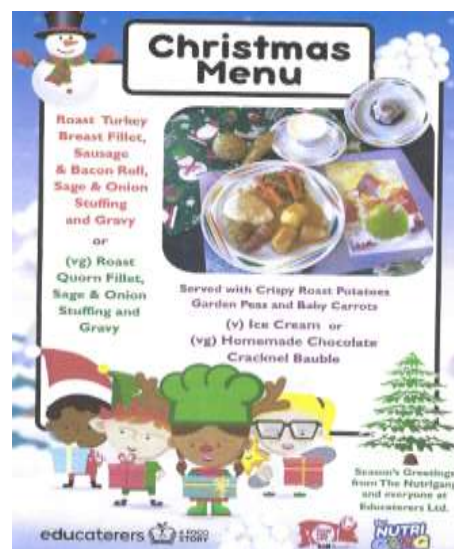
