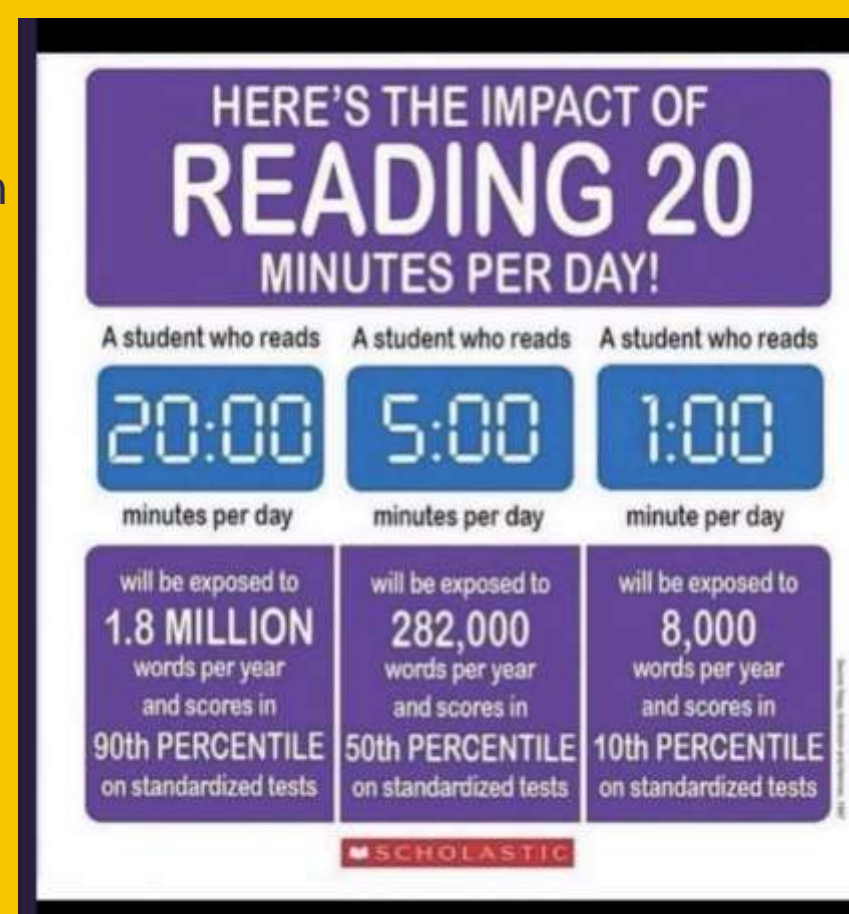
Reading

All children throughout the school will be going home with new home-school Reading Diaries, which will be replacing the current home-school diaries. Any messages for staff will need to be sent via Class Dojo. The reading diaries are for recording any reading completed at home. Please log the date, book title and pages read daily. The children can be responsible for doing this too!

KS2 are expected to read 15 minutes daily. School reading books need to be completed and read through a couple of times if they are short and questions at the back of the book verbally answered with an adult, before they are changed.

At the back of the reading diaries, there is a table for parents to initial and complete once children have read at home. KS2 must read aloud at least twice a week to an adult. When the children have read 5 times in a week, they receive a raffle ticket and will be in with a chance to win some lovely books!

In Reception and Years 1/2 your teachers will be giving you further information about what is required as it also links with the new phonics scheme.

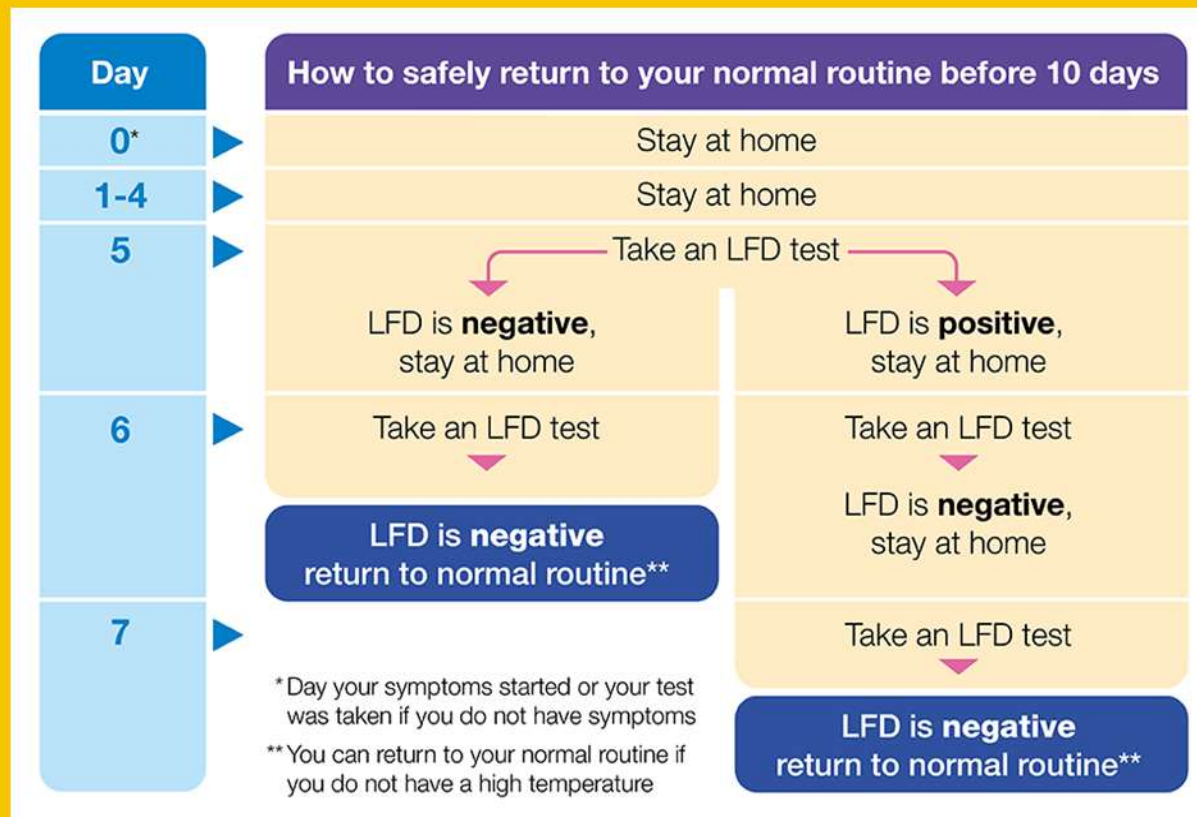

COVID-19

If you have COVID-19, stay at home and avoid contact with other people



If your day 5 LFD test result is positive, you can continue taking LFD tests until you receive 2 consecutive negative test results.

Children and young people with COVID-19 should not attend their education setting while they are infectious. They should take an LFD test from 5 days after their symptoms started (or the day their test was taken if they did not have symptoms) followed by another one the next day. If both these tests results are negative, they should return to their educational setting if they normally attend one, as long as they feel well enough to do so and do not have a temperature. They should follow the guidance for their educational setting.

Avoid meeting people at higher risk of becoming seriously unwell from COVID-19, especially those with a severely weakened immune system, for the 10 days after your symptoms started (or the day your test was taken if you did not have symptoms).
