# Calling all gardeners and non gardeners tomorrow!

We hope you have all noticed the vast improvement to the 'border' of land between Our Lady's fence and the footpath on the Leamington Road.

Last year we planted over 100 daffodil bulbs to the right of the gate and in the summer the council did a good job clearing trees and branches after the storm damage;

We have also cleared most remaining twigs and weeds and most of the area to the left of the school gate is now covered in mulch (forest bark etc).

We want to plant up this area for the spring/summer of 2023 and hope to engage the children in this task. Perhaps we could name this 'The Coronation Border!'

It would be great to have an army of volunteers on Saturday November 5th from 10-12 am, which would coincide with our Open Morning for prospective parents and children. Ideally, we would like a succession of bulb grown flowers from snowdrops, crocuses, daffodils and tulips but any good ground cover plants would be ideal. Additionally, we hope to scatter seeds such as poppies. If you cannot make It that day then we would welcome donations of bulbs, flowers and seeds which we would plant.




### **Our School Lottery**

#### **LEAVE OF ABSENCE & SICKNESS**
