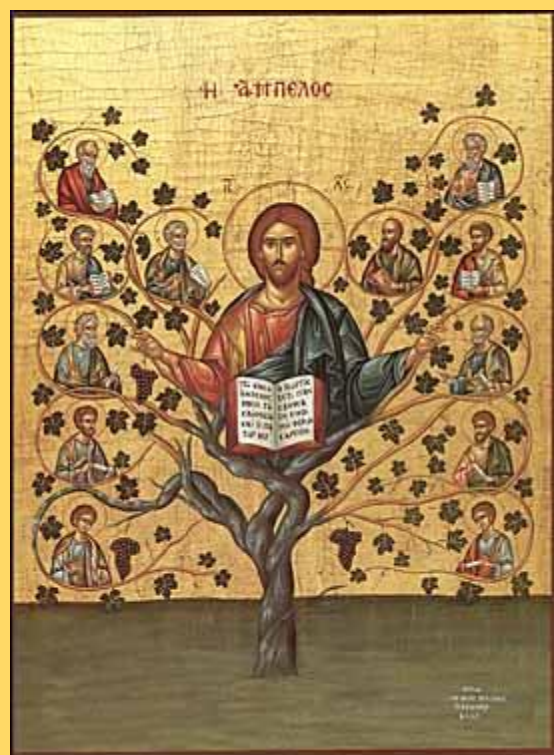
5th Sunday of Easter

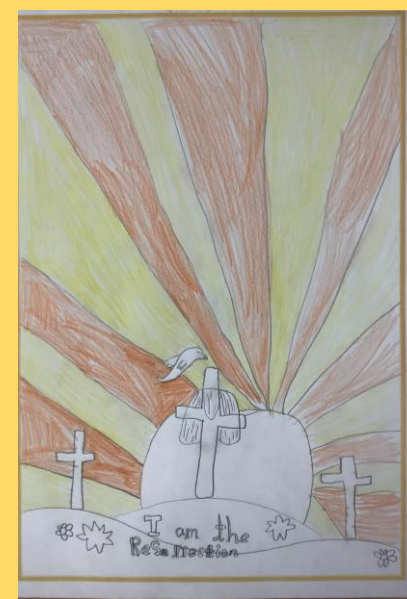

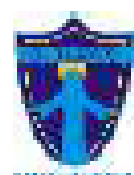
